PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Sodium Nitrite 40–41% Purified Aqueous Solution is a technical-grade inorganic salt solution reclaimed and refined by CHEM Group at its Evansville, Indiana facility. The purification process yields a clear to slightly yellowish liquid with low organic contamination and controlled impurity levels.

Supplied as a ready-to-use solution, it eliminates the handling burden of dry powder — no lifting and dumping 55-pound bags, no caked material, no splashing during solutionizing. Pricing is based on net nitrite content on a dry basis, allowing straightforward cost comparison against dry sodium nitrite.

USE NOTES

As a corrosion inhibitor, sodium nitrite acts as an anodic inhibitor, reacting with dissolved oxygen to form a protective gamma iron oxide film on ferrous surfaces. It is effective in closed-loop cooling and heating systems when formulated at appropriate concentrations — typically with borate buffers at pH 9.0–10.5.

Treatment with acid affords nitrous acid, required for diazotization in dye synthesis and related industrial reactions.

HANDLING & STORAGE

Sodium nitrite is an oxidizer — noncombustible itself, but it will accelerate the burning of combustible materials. Store in a cool, dry area away from incompatible materials including ammonium compounds, strong acids, and combustibles.
